I. Opposition to Senate Bill 420: Geoscience Registry (Title Act)

On behalf of the statewide members of the Wisconsin Society of Professional Engineers (WSPE), we urge the Senate Agriculture & Environmental Resources Committee to oppose Senate Bill 420. We strongly believe that the proposed Title Act model of registration does not protect the public safety and welfare.

Instead, WSPE supports a Practice Act model of licensing for Geologists, Soil Scientists and Hydrologists, with definitions, academic qualifications and scope of practice specifically written into the State Statute.

II. Qualified Support of the Senate Substitute Amendment to 1997 Senate Bill 420

WSPE supports the proposed substitute amendment of SB 420 with qualifications. As stated above, we support the creation of a Practice Act for these professions, rather than a Title Act. Our qualified support of the Substitute Amendment is based on the following concerns:

- 1.. The term "Water Resources" is not acceptable under the Professional Hydrologists Section. At no time is this term defined, nor are the qualifications, educational and exam requirements specified. This addition appears to be an effort to dilute the professional status of hydrologists.

2. On page 27, line 17 should be corrected as follows: Insert - (b) Subject to sub. (7), that he or she has a bachelor's degree with course credits in geology of a variety and nature sufficient to constitute a geology major from a college or university approved by the examining board. - before item (c)
3. After (c) insert - 1. Subject to sub.(5), at least 5 years of professional experience in geologic work of a character satisfactory to the section which demonstrates that the applicant is qualified to assume responsible charge of geologic work. At least 2 years of the geologic work required under this subdivision must have been performed under the supervision of any of the following:
 - a. A person who is licensed as a professional geologist under this chapter or, for work performed before January 1, 1999, who was registered as a professional geologist under ch. 443, 1995 stats.,
 - b. A person who is licensed as a professional geologist in another state or territory or possession of the United States or in another country that has licensure requirements for professional geologists that are substantially equivalent to the requirements for licensure under this chapter.
 - c. Any other person who the section determines is qualified to have responsible charge of geologic work.
4. Subject to sub. (6), at least 7 years of professional experience in geologic work of a character satisfactory to the section which demonstrates that the applicant is qualified to assume responsible charge of geologic work, with a satisfactory evaluation of the last 2 years of the professional experience under a peer review system approved by the section.

Mr. Chairman thank you for the opportunity to speak in support of SB 420 as amended by the Senate:

We have the opportunity today to testify in support of SB 420 for three reasons.

1. Mr. Johnsrud a year and a half ago recognized that the Professional Geology statutes would limit the practice of hydrology and soil science in Wisconsin.
2. The Department of Regulations and Licensing facilitated meetings between all of the groups involved.
3. Senator Welch who advised us on how to amend SB 420 so it would pass in the Senate.

We ask for your support of this bill which establishes standards for geoscience professionals. This amended bill is in harmony with the other established professions in Wisconsin creating practices acts and an examining boards for geology, hydrology and soil science. We found Senator Welch's arguments to amend SB 420 in the Senate very compelling. He said that regulating our professions, using a new model developed by Reg and Licensing, would not pass the Senate because of the opposition to giving the department total control of our professions.

We support the amended bill because we believe it makes sense for a profession being responsible for developing meaningful standards. The profession, through its volunteers sitting on the board, has the obligation to ensure its standards provides the public with adequate safeguards. We strongly believe that these practicing professionals are in the best position to evaluate standards, the applicants for licensing and investigating ethics violations.

The alternative, in the earlier version of SB 420 is for the department of Reg. and Licensing to develop standards, with the professions, acting in an advisory role. The substitute amendment to SB 420 is the result of many months of in depth discussions between our professions and:





I am writing to respond to the March 20, 1998 letter you received from the Committee on Fairness in the Earth Sciences, American Institute of Professional Geologists, and Wisconsin Society of Professional Soil Scientists.

I want to clarify the fact that the Department of Regulation and Licensing does not support Senate Bill 420 as amended by the Senate Substitute Amendment and passed by the State Senate. The department opposes this amended version of the bill because it would result in the creation of a new 12-member examining board and provide for extensive regulation of two new professions, hydrology and soil science, along with professional geologists.

Senate Bill 420 as amended by the Senate is not consistent with the Governor's call for minimal regulation and his position that no new regulatory boards need to be created. The department worked with these interested parties in creating the original version of Senate Bill 420 which is a reasoned response to the unanticipated adverse consequences of the geology statute created in 1994. Currently, the practice of geology is restricted to individuals who are registered as professional geologists. The definition of geology is so broad, some individuals are prohibited from working in the geology-related professions of hydrology and soil science except under the supervision of a registered geologist. Some students in these geology-related professions are unable to meet the educational and examination requirements set by the board that regulates geologists. The registry model established in the original version of Senate Bill 420 responds to these concerns of disenfranchisement by providing minimal regulation and, at the same time, protecting the public.

State regulation by practice acts imposes significant experience, education and examination requirements which can be anti-competitive and limits public access to professional services. Passage of Senate Bill 420 as amended by the State Senate could have the same adverse consequences that the bill is intended to correct.

The department would be able to accept a compromise as follows:


- Eliminate the geologists from consideration for legislative changes. Current statutes regulating geologists to remain intact with geologists regulated by the Joint Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Geologists, Professional Engineers, Designers, and Land Surveyors.

The Department would agree to:

- Registration of hydrologists and soil scientists, with direct regulation of these professions by the department, with assistance from advisory committees appointed by the Secretary and comprised of members of the professions involved.
- Definitions of professional geology, professional hydrology and professional soil science contained in the Senate Substitute Amendment 1 to SB 420 would be included.
- Language similar to Wis. Stats., 443.14 (13), which exempts professional engineers, may need to be included for soil scientists and hydrologists so that if these professionals are performing work related to their professions which would come under the definition of professional geology, they could perform their job without needing to be registered as a professional geologist. I have notified the drafter that this issue should be looked at to determine if this type of language would be necessary.

The department would be willing to participate in the drafting of this compromise. Please let me know if you would like to discuss this in greater detail.

Good afternoon. My name is Steve Karklins. I am a hydrogeologist with the Department of Natural Resources Groundwater Section within the Bureau of Drinking Water and Groundwater. I am here today representing, my supervisor, Mike Lemcke who has been involved in this process for the last several years. I am appearing for informational purposes and in support of the concept of changing existing statutory language to allow qualified professionals to practice in their area of expertise as is the intent in SB 420 and the substitute amendment to SB 420.

The process involved in developing the proposed Professional Geoscientist legislation has been long and well thought out. The various entities have worked hard on developing a satisfactory solution to the parties involved. They have really gone the extra mile in trying to ensure that an implementable solution was developed.

One issue that is important to the department is to make sure that, in the future adopted statutory language, it is clear that agencies which have duties involving the review of information derived from the practice of professional geology, hydrology, or soil science may adopt rules which require that specified activities be performed by persons holding appropriate certificates or registrations under the proposed chapter.

I hope that this Committee is able to carry the torch through the legislative process to get suitable legislation passed on this issue. Thank you for your time and consideration on this important Geoscientist legislation.

More than five years ago, several Wisconsin Section AIPG members (and those representing other organizations) began meeting to discuss Professional Geologist (PG) Registration in Wisconsin. At that time, many states had already developed geologist registration or were in the process of doing so. The Wisconsin DNR and the public were expressing concern regarding the work being performed by consultants at leaking underground storage tank sites, and on other environmental projects. The problems were due to a number of factors, but were caused, in part, by individuals working outside of their area of expertise. Given the natural need for geologist registration, and in response to the concerns of Wisconsin agencies, businesses, and residents, an Ad-hoc Committee, began developing and setting the framework for a geologist registration program in Wisconsin. The intent of the program was to define the geologist's role and the practice of Geology, to establish minimum education and experience requirements for those practicing Geology and to allow for disciplinary action, if needed. After more than two years, the draft legislation was introduced to the legislature, and received wide legislative, regulatory, and business support. The Professional Geologist Registration Act was approved by Governor Tommy Thompson in 1994. Unfortunately, incorporation of the PG into many sections of the Wisconsin Administrative Code still has not been completed, allowing unqualified people to practice geology, resulting in flawed subsurface interpretations and misrepresentations to clients and the public. Action must be taken to correct this problem.


About two years ago, the Wisconsin Section of AIPG was informed that a group of soil scientists and hydrologists had approached the Wisconsin DNR regarding PG registration. The Wisconsin DNR informed AIPG that the organization and its membership must come to a consensus with the soil scientists and hydrologists before PG would be incorporated into the Wisconsin Administrative Code. I am happy to report to you today that an agreement has been reached between AIPG, and the soil scientists and hydrologists. The details of the consensus are outlined in the substitute amendment to Senate Bill SB 420.

AIPG strongly opposed the original version of SB 420 for several reasons. Principally, the original version is written as a Title Act rather than as a Practice Act. This would relax the current PG registration program to a Title Act which would be detrimental to the affected professions and to the public. Since the Title Act is, in effect, voluntary licensing, the Department of Regulation and Licensing will not have control over some practicing geology, soil science, or hydrology. Also, there are no definitions regarding each practice area, science or title. The public will not be able to distinguish individuals "claiming" to be competent from those who actually have the proper education, training, and experience to perform the work. Relaxing the current registration program to a Title Act is a poor idea, and will undoubtedly (once again) result in many problems that will be detrimental to the public good. These opinions are not without foundation. To my knowledge, no state has ever gone from a Practice Act to a Title Act; on the contrary, states have gone from Title Acts to Practice Acts to ensure that qualified professionals are back on the job.

AIPG supports the substitute amendment to SB420, because it is a Practice Act that requires all those practicing to meet minimum education and experience requirements, as well as defines the practice of each profession.
