Dear Senator Weeden and Representative Brancel:

The biennial budget (1995 WI Act 27) requires that all assets and liabilities of the Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS) that are primarily related to the certification of laboratories under section 252.22 of the statutes be transferred to the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP). Section 9126 (31g) (h) of Act 27 requires the Department of Administration (DOA) to submit the proposed transfer to the Joint Committee on Finance no later than June 1, 1996. DOA has reviewed the proposal and finds it reasonable. The proposed transfer includes the following items.

Tangible Personal Property

A desk, 2 drawer file cabinet, 4 drawer file cabinet, computer with stand, desk top lamp, bulletin board, 3 shelf bookcase, desk chair and fleet car #5450 will be transferred from DHSS to DATCP.

Assets and Liabilities

The laboratories certification program will end FY96 with a negative balance of approximately \$32,500. DHSS will transfer this balance to appropriation 101 (GPR) for payment. Therefore there are no liabilities to transfer to DATCP. The only assets to be transferred are the tangible property listed above.

Contracts

There are no contracts to transfer.

Unless a meeting is scheduled in June to review this proposal, I will proceed with the transfer. The effective date of this transfer is July 1, 1996.
