**SENATE AMENDMENT 9,
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 133**

June 30, 1999 – Offered by Senators HUELSMAN, FARROW, DARLING, ROSENZWEIG and PANZER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 1426, line 12: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 3088s.** 813.12 (8) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 813.12 (8) (a) 1.
4 and amended to read:

5 813.12 (8) (a) 1. Whoever Except as provided in subd. 2., whoever knowingly
6 violates a temporary restraining order or injunction issued under sub. (3) or (4) shall
7 be fined not more than \$1,000 or imprisoned for not more than 9 months or both.

8 **SECTION 3088t.** 813.12 (8) (a) 2. of the statutes is created to read:

9 813.12 (8) (a) 2. Whoever knowingly violates a temporary restraining order or
10 injunction issued under sub. (3) or (4) shall be imprisoned for not less than 5 days nor
11 more than 9 months and may be fined not more than \$1,000 if, at any time preceding
12 the violation, the person has been convicted of knowingly violating a temporary
