

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, money has been provided to construct/8 memorials at The Highground in Clark County: one for the veterans of World War I, one for the veterans of World War II and one for the veterans of the Persian Gulf War. The Korean War Veterans Memorial Association of Wisconsin has created a Korean War memorial at Plover in Portage County., This bill appropriates \$90,000 for the perpetual care of the Korean War memorial located at Plover.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 2. 20.485 (2) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

20.485 (2) (e) Korean War memorial at *Plover*. From the general fund, as a continuing appropriation, the amounts in the schedule to provide perpetual care for the Korean War memorial located at Plover in Portage County.

SECTION 3. 45.035 of the statutes is created to read:

45.035 Korean War memorial at Plover. From the appropriation under s. 20.485 (2) (e), the department of veterans affairs shall provide funding to the Korean War Veterans Memorial Association of Wisconsin for the perpetual care of the Korean War memorial located at Plover in Portage County

Please note that s. 16.47 (2); stats., states that neither house may pass any bill containing an appropriation, increasing the cost of state government or decreasing state revenues by more than \$10,000 annually until both houses pass the executive budget bill, except that the governor or joint committee on finance or, under certain circumstances, the committee on organization of either house may enact emergency appropriation bills prior to the passage of the executive budget bill.

If this bill is introduced and enacted as an emergency measure prior to passage of the budget, the appropriation set forth in this bill will be repealed by action of the budget bill (which repeals and recreates the appropriations schedule). You may instead wish to consider having this bill drafted as an amendment to the budget bill to include the correct appropriation line amount. Alternatively, you may wish to include an effective date that is later than the projected date for passage of the budget bill. Finally, you may instead wish to introduce this bill for potential passage after the passage of the budget bill. If you choose this option, please check with me after budget passage to ensure that the cross references in this bill are still accurate and that the numbers for created statutes in the bill have not been supplanted by the budget bill.
