Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under current law, a town may enact a zoning ordinance regulating trash dumping along streams and natural watercourses. Under the bill, a town may enact a dumping ordinance that applies to the town's entire territory. In addition, under the bill, towns and counties may provide for a forfeiture for violating a dumping ordinance. Also, under the bill, towns, counties, and town sanitary districts may publicize the names of persons that violate dumping ordinances.

The number of units of local government that would enact ordinances under the bill and the number of violators of those ordinances cannot be determined. Therefore, neither the increase in forfeitures under the bill, nor the cost of publicizing violators' names, can be determined.
