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- 3. The department of administration will be responsible for the management of the revenue generation and repayment process that will provide the \$450,000,000 in funding for claim payment.
- 4. The process changes detailed in the bill will be able to be accomplished by a shifting of program emphasis in work processes. The system changes suggested in the bill focus primarily on the technical/hydrogeologic side of the PECFA program and efforts will be made to emphasize the work processes in the bill and reduce work time associated with other program areas. Final impact of the changes, however, can only be gauged after actual implementation of the work systems in order to know the impact of changes like the prioritization of sites (for starting dates) will have on the total workload of the program.
