1	AN ACT <i>to renumber and amend</i> 118.25 (3); and <i>to create</i> 118.25 (3) (b) of the
2	statutes; relating to: physical health examinations of pupils.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 118.25 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 118.25 (3) (a) and amended to read:

118.25 **(3)** (a) In <u>Subject to par. (b), in</u> counties having a population of less than 500,000, the school board may require <u>periodic health examinations of pupils by physicians a pupil to be periodically examined by a physician, under the supervision of <u>a</u> local health <u>departments department</u> and the department of health and family services, <u>and</u>. The school board may pay the cost of the examinations out of school district funds.</u>

SECTION 2. 118.25 (3) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

118.25 (3) (b) Annually by September 1, a school board that wishes to examine a pupil under par. (a) shall mail the adult pupil or the parent or guardian of a minor pupil a schedule of the number and dates of the examinations that the school board plans to conduct during the school year and a detailed description of the nature of each examination. The school board may not conduct any examination for which the adult pupil or the parent or guardian of a minor pupil has not consented in writing. The school board may conduct an examination in addition to those on the schedule if the school board mails the adult pupil or the parent or guardian of a minor pupil a revised schedule and obtains the written consent of the adult pupil or the parent or guardian of a minor pupil to conduct the additional examination.
