Enactment of this bill could possibly increase costs to the State Public Defender's Office (SPD) in the following ways:						
1) Possible challenges to the law, such as equal protection, could be raised.						
2) Expert costs may increase with such a plea and verdict.						
3) Such a plea and verdict may decrease the number of stipulated NGI (not guilty by reason of mental disease or defect) pleas, thus increasing the number of jury trials held. On the other hand, such a plea and verdict may help in plea negotiations, thus decreasing the number of jury trials held.
