## Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a county clerk may issue a marriage license to individuals who apply and present proof of identification and residence. The application must contain the social security numbers of the individuals, as well as other information required by the department of health and family services. Any individual who is under the age of 30 years must show the county clerk a certified copy of his or her birth certificate. If an individual has been previously married, he or she must submit to the clerk a copy of a divorce judgment or a copy of his or her former spouse's death certificate.

This bill provides that a county clerk may not issue a marriage license to individuals who apply unless, in addition to all the other requirements under current law, they have received at least two hours of premarital counseling. The individuals must present to the clerk a notarized attestation of the person who provided the counseling, which the clerk attaches to any marriage license issued. Counseling may be provided by a marriage and family therapist, a professional counselor, a member of the clergy or a person designated by a member of the clergy. At least one hour of
the counseling must be the parenting of children and at least one hour must be related to marriage issues.
