I am requesting a bill draft that amends s 118.045 (as created by 1999 Act 9) to change the time period that a school board may hold a public hearing on the issue of starting the school year prior to September 1. Current law implies that the public hearing and action by the school board to approve an earlier start date may not occur until the school year for which the start date would be changed. The school year has been defined as the fiscal year which starts on July 1.

My bill would allow school boards to hold the public hearing and adopt a resolution for an earlier start date based on the calendar year in which the school start date occurs, specifically January 1.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law prohibits a school district from starting the school term before September 1 unless in that school year the school board holds a public hearing and adopts a resolution approving an earlier starting date. This bill provides that the school board may hold the public hearing and adopt the resolution in the calendar year in which the earlier starting date falls.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

Section 1. 118.045 (3) of the statutes, as created by 1999 Wisconsin Act 9, is
