Summary

This motion would retain PSC rulemaking authority for specifications of telecommunication services eligible for funding through the TEACH program. Currently, the TEACH board is responsible for awarding grants for the educational telecommunication access program while the PSC is responsible for the rulemaking and reporting aspects of the program.

The Governor/JFC provision transfers the PSC's rulemaking and reporting functions related to the educational telecommunication access program to the TEACH Board.
