Budget Amendments 1999- 2000

Statement of Intent PSC. Prohibit the owner of a mobile home park from preventing a cable TV operator from providing service to a resident of the mobile home park.

Summary This amendment would add a clause to Wis. Statute 66.085(2) stating that a mobile home park is a type of multi-unit dwelling. The purpose would be to prevent an owner or manager of a mobile home park from interfering with a cable operator providing cable services to a subscriber who is a resident of a mobile home park.

There are several instances where the owner or manager of a mobile home park makes specific demands of a cable operator before he allows the operator to provide service to residents of the park that he manages. Demands such as financial kickbacks or free service are common. This practice was common with managers and owners of condominiums and apartment complexes before they were offered this type of protection.

This is the proposed change to the statute:

66.085(2)

(2) Interference prohibited. The owner or manager of a multiunit dwelling under common ownership, control or management or the association or board of directors of a condominium [or mobile home park] may not prevent a cable operator from providing cable service to a subscriber who is a resident of the multiunit dwelling or of the condominium or interfere with a cable operator providing cable service to a subscriber who is a resident of the multiunit dwelling or of the condominium [or mobile home park].

Fiscal Impact According to the Legislative Fiscal Bureau, there should be no fiscal impact associated with this amendment.
