In this amendment, I placed all of the employees at the state fair park board in the unclassified service; for current employees, however, I provided in the amendment that they retain their classified civil service rights with respect to demotion, suspension, discharge, layoff or reduction in base pay. If this is not your intent, please let me know and I will redraft.

CAUCUS AMENDMENT

TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,

TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 133

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 415, line 18: after that line insert:

3 “**SECTION 648r.** 20.923 (6) (hq) of the statutes is created to read:

4 20.923 (6) (hq) State fair park board: staff employes.”.

5 **2.** Page 537, line 19: after that line insert:

6 “**SECTION 945dm.** 42.035 of the statutes is created to read:

7 **42.035 Treatment of certain state fair park board employes.**

8 Notwithstanding s. 230.08 (2) (pm), those employes holding positions in the

9 classified service at the state fair park board on the effective date of this section

10 [revisor inserts date], who have achieved permanent status in class before that date,

1 shall retain, while serving in the unclassified service at the state fair park board,
2 those protections afforded employes in the classified service under ss. 230.34 (1) (a)
3 and 230.44 (1) (c) relating to demotion, suspension, discharge, layoff or reduction in
4 base pay. Those employes of the state fair park board on the effective date of this
5 section [revisor inserts date], who have not achieved permanent status in class
6 in any position at the state fair park board on that date are eligible to receive the
7 protections, privileges and rights preserved under this section if they successfully
8 complete service equivalent to the probationary period required in the classified
9 service for the position that they hold on that date.”.

10 **3.** Page 1198, line 14: after that line insert:

11 “**SECTION 2362p.** 230.08 (2) (pm) of the statutes is amended to read:

12 230.08 (2) (pm) The All employes of the state fair park director board.”.
