This provision deletes JFC action relating to the development of a pesticide database and instead calls for one-time funding for a pesticide database study. Funding would be used to study the feasibility of creating a database that records the level of pesticide use by farmers, other businesses, government and homeowners in the state.

JFC created a comprehensive pesticide sales and use reporting system.

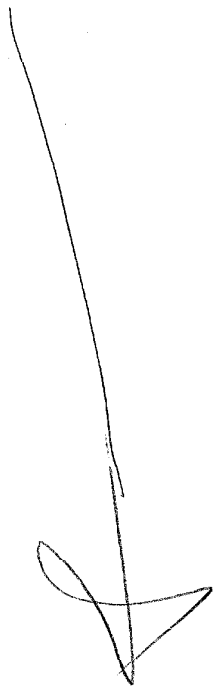

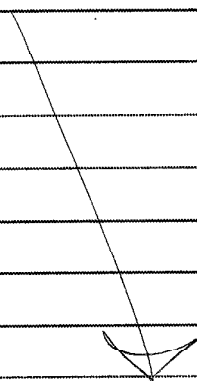

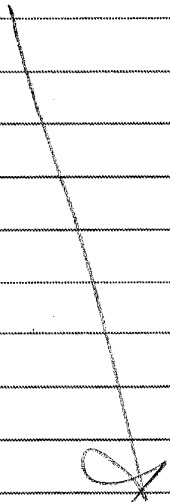
