### Summary

Move to replace the provision in Motion #1201 (reflected in alternative A2(b), paper #510) that requires DHFS to obtain approval of the Board before implementing cost containment procedures such as the creation of prior authorization requirements with a requirement that DHFS consult with the Board on prior authority policy.

### Fiscal Impact

### Statement of Intent

Prior authorization requirements are clinical decisions that are made by medical experts and are introduced in order to assure the medical necessity of a particular procedure, therapy, or pharmaceutical. The HIRSP Board neither represents sufficient medical expertise nor was designed to make frequent decisions.

With the continual advent of new procedures, therapies and pharmaceuticals, it is not realistic or prudent for the DHFS to be required to obtain approval from the Board for specific prior authorization decisions.

Consultations with the Board on prior authorizations policy represents the appropriate level of review necessary given the periodicity of Board meetings.
