VII. Technical Adjustments to Non-point Program

JFC Action

The Committee provided improvements to the nonpoint source pollution abatement program in motion #277. JFC increased bonding levels for rural priority watershed projects by \$6 million, urban projects by \$15 million, urban flood control by \$3 million and clean water fund bonding by \$4.1 million, for a total of \$28.1 million in additional general obligation bonding in the biennium. Debt service would increase by about \$2.3 million GPR annually after all bonds were issued. This provides DNR with \$43.7 million, DATCP with \$11.2 million and at least \$4 million in federal funds for local assistance (staffing) and local cost share grants. Thus, under the proposal, at least \$87 million would be available for local grants. The proposal also expanded the program to include providing funding for threatened waters and outstanding resource waters. The DNR competitive nonpoint grants program is expanded, but no funding is designated for the program. (Under the funding plan devised by the departments, funding would be expected to be available beginning in 2003.) Further, the motion deleted \$294,000 in nonpoint SEG annually to maintain expenditures with in available revenues. **Motion #277 passed on a 13-3 vote.**

Motion:

Move to provide adjustments to JFC Motion 277, which redesigns the Non-point Source Pollution Abatement Program.

1. Increase DATCP's base budget for the soil and water resource management program by \$6.5 million in FY 2000 - 01 to fund the nonpoint redesign implementation. Transfer \$3.5 million in GPR funds from 20.370(6)(aa) to 20.115(7)(c), and \$3 million in SEG funds from 20.370(6)(aq) to 20.115(7)(qd) to accomplish this purpose. ?
2. Clarify that DATCP is not limited in the amount of cost share money allocated in a given year to an individual county land conservation department for implementation of an approved land and water resource management plan. *DNate*
- ✓ 3. Require DATCP to provide technical assistance to county land conservation committees for the development of any local ordinance which implements agricultural performance standards adopted under s. 92.07(2), s. 92.105(1), s. 92.15(2) and (3) or s. 281.16(3), Stats. Specify that DATCP's technical assistance includes but is not limited to preparing model ordinances, providing data concerning these standards, and reviewing and approving draft ordinances for compliance with applicable state statutes and administrative rules.
4. Create three new staff positions at DATCP for implementation of the redesigned nonpoint programs. Transfer \$170,000 in SEG funds from 20.370(6)(aq) to 20.115(7)(qd) in FY 1999-00 and \$190,000 in SEG funds from 20.370(6)(aq) to 20.115(7)(qd) in FY 2000-01 to pay for these new staff positions.
5. Change bonding levels created by JFC to the following: urban projects: \$10 million, urban flood control: \$8 million. (no change to JFC, just redistribution)

Fiscal Impact

Transfer \$3.5 million in GPR funds from DNR to DATCP and \$3 million in SEG funds in FY 2000 - 01 to fund nonpoint redesign implementation. Transfer \$170,000 in SEG funds from DATCP to DNR in FY 1999-00 and \$190,000 in SEG funds from DNR to DATCP in FY 2000-01 to pay for three new staff positions. (No new money is provided by this motion.). Change bonding levels created by JFC to the following: urban projects: \$10 million, urban flood control: \$8 million. (no change to JFC, just redistribution)

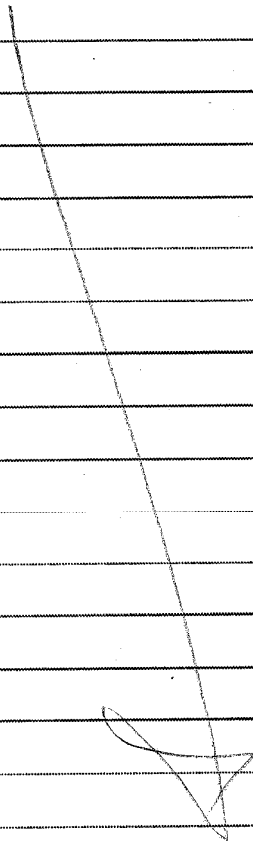
