Summary

Action taken by the Joint Finance Committee would provide \$120,000 PR annually and 1.5 PR positions to the Department of Health and Family Services to implement a voluntary health plan data collection project. The project will allow DHFS to develop an annual guide to assist consumers in selecting health providers and health care plans.

This amendment delays authorization of the \$120,000 PR and 1.5 positions to DHFS until agreement has been reached between DHFS, the Department of Employee Trust Funds' Division of Health Care Financing and the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance for permanent consolidation of collected health plan data. The Bureau of Health Information (within DHFS) would be required to submit a consolidated data collection plan and a detailed memorandum of understanding signed by each participating agency to the Department of Administration for review. The agencies would be required to report to DOA any potential cost savings from a consolidated data collection plan.

Fiscal Impact

Reduce PR funding for a voluntary health plan data project by \$60,000 in 1999-2000.

Statement of Intent

Department of Administration. Consolidation of state data collection efforts on health information from several different agencies (Bureau of Health Information, Department of Employee Trust funds, Division of Health Care Financing, and the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance into a single agency (BHI).
