SPENDING REDUCTIONS

Health and Family Services

1. *Health Insurance Risk-Sharing Plan.* Reduce GPR support for the health insurance risk-sharing plan (HIRSP) by \$2,000,000 GPR in 2000-01 so that \$9,900,000 GPR would be provided annually to offset program costs, as recommended by the Governor. The Joint Committee on Finance increased the funding amount recommended by the Governor by \$2,000,000 GPR in 2000-01 to restore base funding for the program (\$11,900,000) in 2000-01.

2. *Statewide Automated Child Welfare Information System.* Reduce funding that would be provided to offset county costs of implementing the statewide automated child welfare information system (SACWIS) by \$500,000 in 2000-01 by: (a) reducing DHFS funding by \$1,000,000 FED in 2000-01 to reflect the deletion of federal income augmentation funds budgeted for this purpose (\$500,000) and the reduction in Title IV-E matching funds budgeted to support these expenditures (\$500,000); and (b) reducing funding by \$500,000 PR in 2000-01 to reflect that the Title IV-E funds would not be transferred from the DHFS Division of Children and Family Services to the DHFS Division of Management and Technology. Finally, require DHFS to lapse \$500,000 in income augmentation funds to the general fund no later than 30 days after the effective date of the bill.

3. *Federally Qualified Health Centers.* Reduce funding for grants to community, migrant and homeless health centers that are designated as federally qualified health centers by \$1,750,000 GPR in 1999-00 and \$2,000,000 GPR in 2000-01. The Joint Committee on Finance created a new grant program for the 13 community, migrant and homeless health centers in the state and provided \$3.5 million in 1999-00 and \$4.0 million in 2000-01 for these grants.

4. *Family Planning.* Reduce funding by \$30,000 GPR annually for oral health programs for children so that \$320,000 GPR annually would be provided for this purpose. This reduction reflects a reestimate of the amount of funding necessary to maintain the state's commitment for the federal maternal and child health block grant. Under a previous motion, the Assembly Republican Caucus eliminated state funding for family planning and provided \$350,000 for children's oral health services to maintain the state's commitment for the federal maternal and child health block grant. It is estimated that \$250,000 in 1999-00 and \$40,000 in 2000-01 would be required to maintain the state's commitment and to ensure the state's continued eligibility for these block grant funds.

CAUCUS AMENDMENT

TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,

TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 133

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 1. Page 201, line 21: decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 1999-00 by
3 \$1,750,000 and decrease the dollar amount for fiscal year 2000-01 by \$2,000,000 for
4 the purpose of decreasing the funding for grants to federally qualified health centers.

5 2. Page 1211, line 9: delete "\$3,500,000" and substitute "\$1,750,000".

6 3. Page 1211, line 9: delete "\$4,000,000" and substitute "\$2,000,000".
