SPENDING REDUCTIONS

Administration

1. ~~*Funding for Operation Fresh Start Replication Projects.*~~ Modify Joint Finance provision by deleting \$92,000 GPR annually of the amount reserved in the Committee's appropriation for Operation Fresh Start replication projects and transferring the remaining balance (\$140,000 GPR annually) from the Committee's appropriation to DOA's grants to local housing organizations appropriation. This action would provide funding for four Operation Fresh Start replication projects annually, based on the current level of firm funding commitments to the program from other sources.

2. *State Agency Membership Dues.* Include a session law provision to require the Secretary of the Department of Administration to lapse to the general fund in 1999-00 and in 2000-01 from each state agency an amount equal to 10% of the amounts expended in 1998-99 by each agency for the costs of membership dues in national and state organizations. Increase estimated GPR-earned for 1999-00 and 2000-01 by \$567,500 in each year.
