9 “**SECTION 2955c.** 560.155 of the statutes is created to read:

10 **560.155 Business employes' skills training financial assistance**
11 **program.** (1) From the appropriations under s. 20.143 (1) (d) and (Lm), the
12 department may award financial assistance as provided in sub. (2) (a) to a business
13 if all of the following apply:

14 (a) The business is located in this state and satisfies any of the following
15 criteria:

16 1. The business has no more than 35 full-time employes.

17 2. The business had no more than \$2,500,000 in gross annual income in the
18 year preceding the year in which the business receives the financial assistance.

19 (b) The business uses the financial assistance to provide skills training or other
20 education related to the needs of the business to current or prospective employes of
21 the business.

22 (c) The business submits a plan to the department detailing the proposed use
23 of the financial assistance and the secretary approves the plan.

1 (d) The business enters into a written agreement with the department that
2 specifies the conditions for the use of the financial assistance, including reporting,
3 auditing and repayment requirements.

4 (e) The business agrees in writing that, before providing training or other
5 education to a current or prospective employe with the financial assistance, it will
6 enter into a contract with the employe under which the business agrees to retain the
7 employe, and the employe agrees to work for the business, for at least one year after
8 the employe's training or education is completed.

9 (f) The business agrees in writing to submit to the department the report
10 required under sub. (3) by the time required under sub. (3).

11 (2) (a) The department may not award a business more than \$10,000 in
12 financial assistance under this section. One-half of the amount awarded to a
13 business shall be a grant and one-half shall be a loan.

14 (b) In awarding financial assistance under this section, the department shall
15 give preference to businesses in industries with especially severe labor shortages.
16 The department shall consult with the department of workforce development to
17 determine which industries are experiencing severe labor shortages.

18 (3) A business that receives financial assistance under this section shall submit
19 to the department, within 6 months after spending the full amount of the proceeds,
20 a report detailing how the proceeds were used."
