Under the substitute amendment, the MPS board does not have to submit the building plan to the joint finance committee until May, 1 2000, and the joint finance committee has until September, 1, 2000 to modify the plan. The proposal for Rep. Cullen calls for a referendum to be held by April, 2000, on the building plan. Thus, if a plan were approved by referendum before April, 2000, it could be modified by the joint finance committee before September, thereby necessitating another referendum. This amendment, instead, requires a referendum to be held before implementation of any plan approved by joint finance. Does this capture Rep. Cullen's intent?

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
