Revert back to the JFC position on the construction of a full-scale aquaculture demonstration facility near Ashland.

Add to JFC Motion 21 relating to the Aquaculture Center (UW System) the following:  
(f) a Memorandum of Understanding between the UW System, the State, the City of Ashland, and the Aquaculture Industry that (1) there will be aquaculturists on the board or committee in charge of the management of the Ashland Aquaculture Center, (2) the Aquaculture Industry will in no way be responsible for the costs related to the construction or operation of the facility, and (3) providing what types of research is done and how that research will be readily available to Fish Farmers of our state, at little or no cost.

The following proposals would be funded by ending the sales tax exemption on ATM machines: ~~(\$250,000)~~ (Fund for 2nd year of biennium)

- Provide \$50,000 annually to the UW System to the UW Extension to disseminate to the Aquaculture Industry statewide the results of practical research of the industry.
- Provide \$250,000 annually to the DATCP ADD Program for immediate research needed to assist the Aquaculture Industry in meeting its short-term product demand.
- Authorize a FTE position at DATCP-Marketing for Aquaculture promotion at \$50,000 annually.
- Re-authorize one LTE position at DATCP-Marketing to serve the needs of the Aquaculture Industry at \$25,000 annually.
