CURRENT LAW

Base level funding of \$155,100 GPR is included under the Legislature's membership in national organizations sum sufficient appropriation to support dues payments to the national associations and bodies that the Legislature chooses to join.

GOVERNOR

Reestimate the sum sufficient membership in national organizations appropriation by \$4,900 GPR in 1999-00 and \$10,000 GPR in 2000-01 to fully fund total projected dues payments of \$160,000 GPR in 1999-00 and \$165,100 GPR in 2000-01.

MODIFICATION TO BASE

Modify the dues payments as recommended by the Governor as shown in the table:

Explanation: The annual dues assessment for the National Conference of Insurance Legislators has increased from \$2,000 annually to \$5,000 annually but was not reflected in the Governor's recommendation.. In addition, the National Association on Administrative Rules Review has ceased operation and the \$500 GPR currently budgeted annually for this purpose is no longer needed. The modification would reestimate the net amount required for dues payments by an additional \$2,500 GPR annually to reflect these two changes.
