GENERAL FUND TAXES

Sales Tax Exemption for Materials, Supplies and Fuel for Railroad Tracks and Right-of-Way

Motion:

Move to provide a sales and use tax exemption for the gross receipts from the sale of and the storage, use or other consumption of materials, supplies and fuel used in the maintenance of railroad tracks and rights-of-way. Specify that this provision would be effective on the first day of the second month beginning after publication of the bill.

Note:

Under current law, the 5% general sales tax applies to sales of materials, supplies and fuel used in the maintenance of railroad tracks and rights-of-way. This motion would provide a sales tax exemption for sales, storage and use of such items. Based on information provided by the Wisconsin Railroad Committee, it is estimated that the proposed exemption would reduce general fund tax collections by \$710,000 in 1999-00 and \$940,000 in 2000-01, assuming an effective date of October 1, 1999. In addition, because the county and stadium district sales taxes are piggy-backed on the state sales tax, it is anticipated that such revenues would decrease by \$115,000 for the 1999-01 biennium.
