Under current law, any unused tuition grant funds are lapsed back into the general fund. The Governor's budget bill continued funding for the tuition grant program at the base level of \$3,589,400 GPR annually. Joint Finance provided the department with 13.10 authority for this program.

 Subject: Amendment to Authorize BIENNIAL funding for the National Guard
 Tuition Grant Program (Sections 20.465 (2) and 21.49 Stat's)

1. Assembly Bill 133, the 1999-2001 Budget, currently contains language that authorizes the Department of Military Affairs to use the appropriation under Section 20.465 (2) for tuition grants only within each individual year of the biennial period. This is accomplished by making the appropriation in the schedule an annual (A) appropriation and in the appropriation language by describing it in the definitional language as an "annual" appropriation.
 2. The Department has suggested that it would have more flexibility in meeting its funding obligation under this grant program if it were allowed to carry any potential surplus from the first year of the biennium into the second year. You have requested that we provide you with the instructions to amend the budget proposal to accomplish this.
 3. There are two changes required in the budget:
 - a) The first is in the appropriation schedules – the appropriation for section 20.465 (2) needs to be changed from annual, indicated by an "A" to a biennial, indicated by a "B".
 - b) The second change is to the verbal language of the appropriation for section 20.465 (2). The defining paragraph has to start with the words "A biennial appropriation", or "Biennially", or words to that effect, rather than stating an annual appropriation.
 4.  the payment of tuition grants to members of the Wisconsin national guard under s.
 21.49 (3)."
