The Plover Heritage Park is an historical village within the Village of Plover consisting of 8 buildings constructed between 1857 and 1898. The original structure was a church, now a museum, built in 1857 and listed on the National Historic Register. The Historical Society is in the process of restoring and refurbishing the remaining buildings.

The language should allow the Portage County Historical Society to collect and record contributions toward the local match over the biennium, with the state's matching grant provided between 1999-2001, when the society reaches its goal.
