1 **AN ACT to repeal 121.90 (1) (a) to (d); and to renumber and amend 121.90 (1)**  
2 **(intro.) of the statutes; relating to: counting summer school enrollment for**  
3 **revenue limit purposes.**

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

Current law limits the annual increase in a school district's revenue derived from general school aid and property taxes. This revenue limit is calculated by comparing a school district's average pupil enrollment in the three previous school years. Current law also phases into this pupil enrollment average 20% of summer school enrollment. This bill includes 100% of a school district's summer school enrollment in the pupil enrollment.
