Access Full Federal Child Care and Development Fund

Direct the Department of Workforce Development to review all allowable sources of matching funds to access the full federal allocation (approx. \$44 million over the biennium) available to Wisconsin from the Child Care and Development Fund, for new and expanded child care programs.

And, provide language for expenditure authority for these additional funds to the Office of Child Care of the Department of Workforce Development.

Note:

Sources of matching funds to access the Federal Child Care and Development Fund include:

State GPR spending on 4-year old kindergarten programs (approx. \$35 million GPR per year -- 20% of the match used for this program could be counted as a match for new CCDF money, or approx. \$3 million/year. With this match the state would get \$4.5 million per year for new programs).

State GPR spending on early childhood special education programs (3-5 year olds)

Local property tax dollars spent on child care services (Madison spends approx. \$1.5 million per year).

Private funds contributed to designated agencies for child care services

State gpr funds allocated for Head Start expansion (\$3.75 million/yr in this budget).

CAUCUS AMENDMENT

TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,

TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 133

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 1. Page 1566, line 17: after that line insert:

3 "(3mm) CHILD CARE AND DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS. No later than
4 September 1, 1999, the department of workforce development shall identify all
5 existing general purpose revenues that may be used to match federal child care and
6 development block grant funds. The department shall prepare a plan to maximize
7 federal funding for child care and shall submit the plan to the secretary of the federal
8 department of health and human services no later than October 1, 1999. No later
9 than 60 days after the secretary of the federal department of health and human

1 services approves the plan, the department shall submit to the joint committee on
2 finance a plan for expanding child care.”
