## **Background on Kenosha County Healthy Families Program**

- Program's inception was in March of 1997 to prevent the abuse and neglect of children born to teen mothers.
- Kenosha County has the second highest teen pregnancy rate in the State of Wisconsin, steadily increasing the number of children at risk for abuse and neglect.
- Almost 30 percent of child abuse and neglect reports received by the county's Division of Children and Family Services involve children of families started by teen parents.
- A funding increase of \$100,000 per year would add four new home visiting positions to the Health Families Program.
- An additional 60 teen mothers under the age of 18 and their babies would receive regular home visits during a one year period.
- There are approximately 90 births per year to mothers under the age of 18 in Kenosha County, with 50 percent of those accepting home visiting services.
