Description: Changes to the library aid formula

Under this legislation, if there is an increase of less than approximately 20% in state aid to public library systems, all library systems would be treated equally and each system would receive the same percentage increase or decrease in state aid. This would prevent a situation from occurring in which systems receive various levels of increases, or in the case of no increase in state aid some systems receive an increase in aid while others receive a decrease. If there were an increase in system aid of approximately 20% or more, a new distribution formula would go into effect.

Fiscal effect: None – redistribution of aid

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Currently, the amount of state aid paid to a public library system is based on three factors: geographical area, population and expenditures.

This bill provides that each system's portion of the total amount of state aid appropriated for library aid is determined by multiplying the amount received by the system in the previous fiscal year by one plus the percentage change in the total amount appropriated. Beginning in the fiscal year in which the total amount appropriated equals at least 11.25% of the total operating expenditures for public library services from local and county sources, the amount paid to a system is determined by adding all of the following:

1. The system's percentage of the state's population multiplied by 85% of the total amount appropriated for library aid.
2. The system's percentage of the state's geographical area multiplied by 7.5% of the total amount appropriated for library aid.
3. The system's percentage of shared revenue payments multiplied by 7.5% of the total amount appropriated for library aid.

The fiscal effect of this bill on public library systems will be a redistribution of aid, resulting in decreases and increases in amounts received depending on the total amount of system aid appropriated.

Because the amount that the legislature will appropriate to public library system aid is unknown, the fiscal effect of this bill is indeterminable.

1 **AN ACT** to amend 43.24 (1) (intro.); and to repeal and recreate 43.24 (1) (a),
2 43.24 (1) (b) and 43.24 (1) (c) of the statutes; relating to: state aid to public
3 library systems and granting rule-making authority.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, the amount of state aid paid to a public library system is based on three factors: geographical area, population and expenditures.

This bill provides that each system's portion of the total amount of state aid appropriated for library aid is determined by multiplying the amount received by the system in the previous fiscal year by one plus the percentage change in the total amount appropriated. Beginning in the fiscal year in which the total amount appropriated equals at least 11.25% of the total operating expenditures for public library services from local and county sources, the amount paid to a system is determined by adding all of the following:

1. The system's percentage of the state's population multiplied by 85% of the total amount appropriated for library aid.
2. The system's percentage of the state's geographical area multiplied by 7.5% of the total amount appropriated for library aid.
3. The system's percentage of shared revenue payments multiplied by 7.5% of the total amount appropriated for library aid.

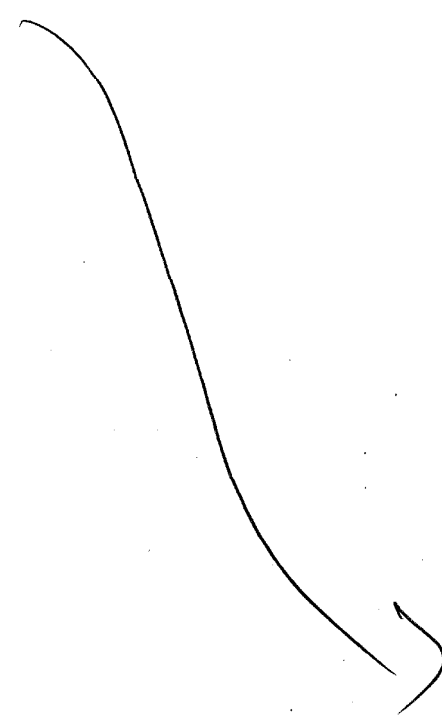
