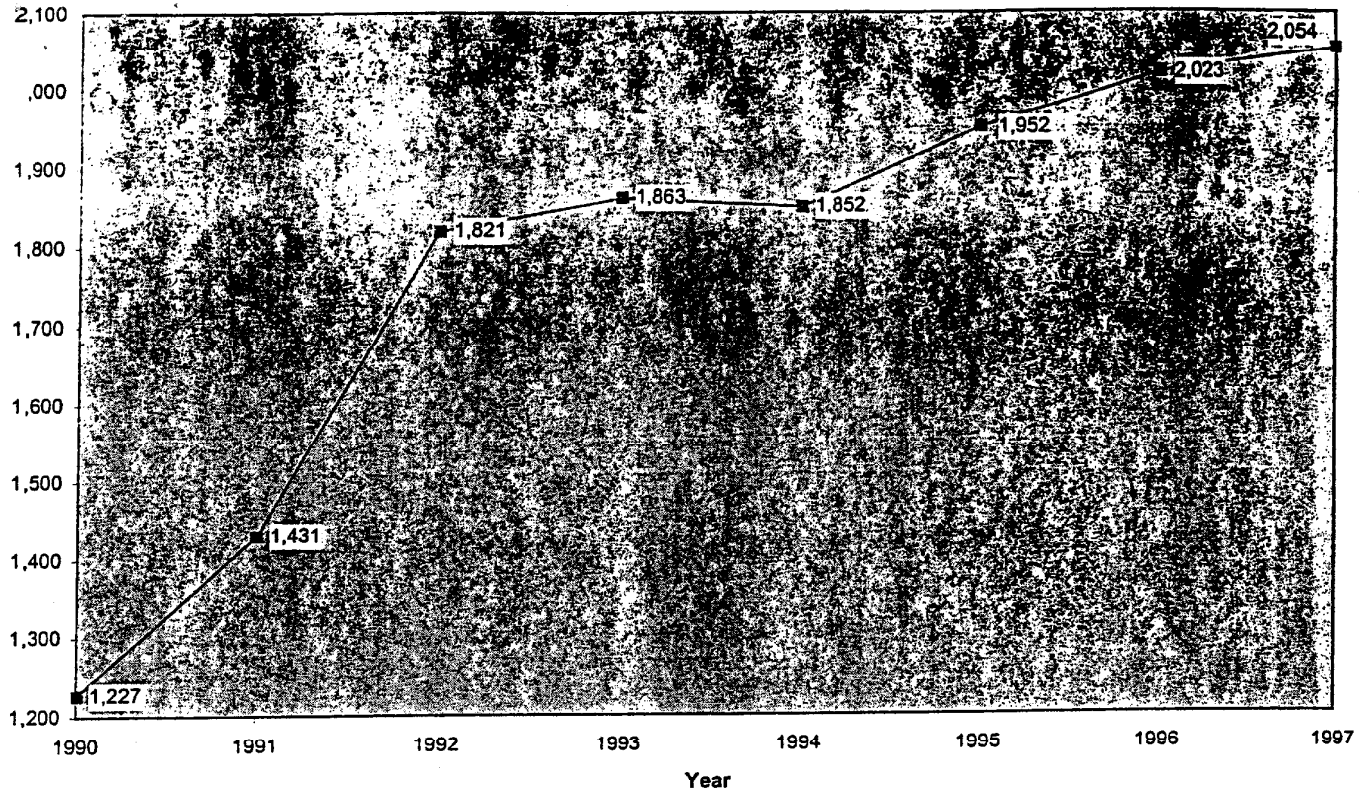

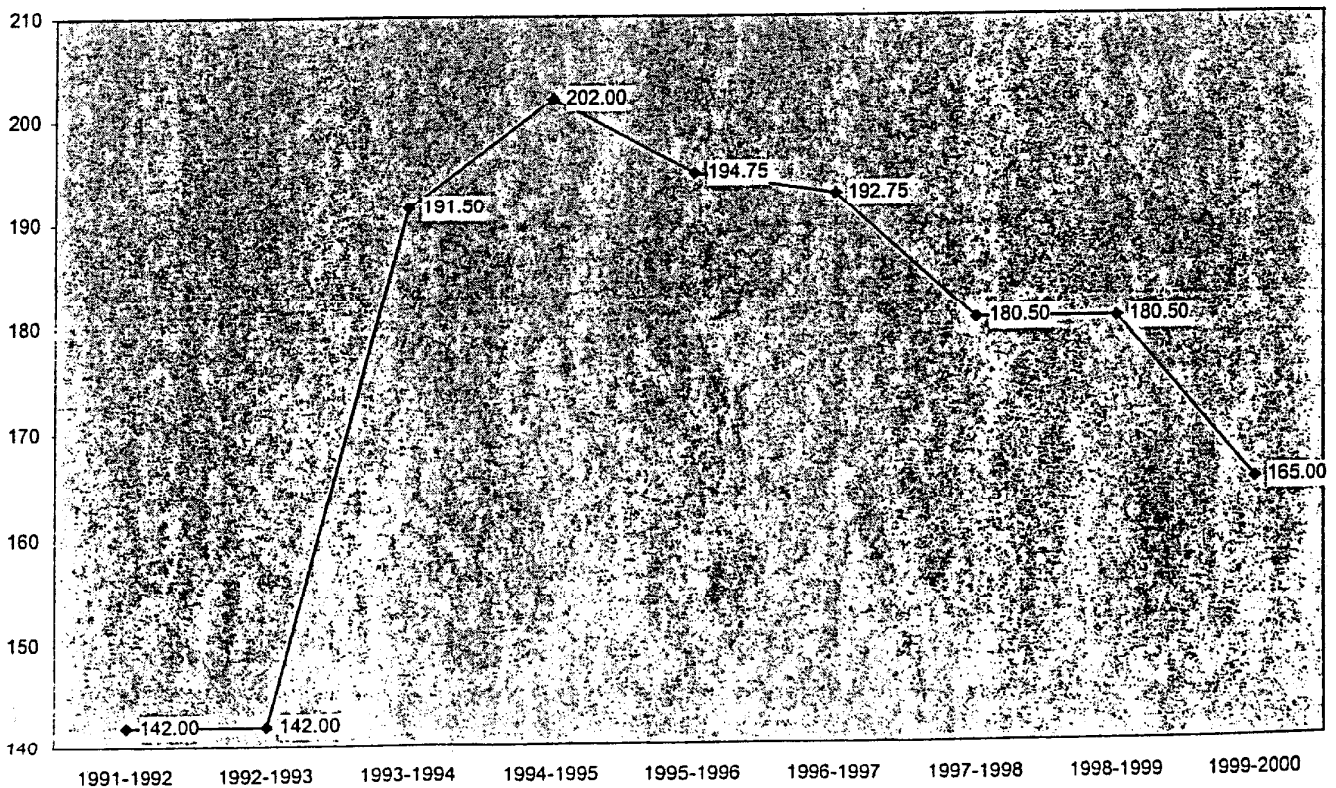

- The \$1.6 million in the Governor's budget will increase air compliance efforts. This is important because there has been an increase in USEPA oversight as a direct result of DNR's work reduction in compliance.
  - DNR will increase its inspections of facilities. Since 1995 inspections have dropped from 800 to 600 annually. It is important to get this number back up to 1995 levels.
  - Since 1990 the number of facilities that are required to report their annual emission of air contaminants has increased 40% (from 1,200 to 2,000 facilities). This reflects the increased workload resulting from significant new requirements in the 1999 Clean Air Act Amendments.
  - A reduction of 37 positions in the Air Management Program has occurred since 1995. This threatens DNR's ability to continue implementing federal air quality requirements for the state. USEPA would assume these responsibilities if they determine that DNR does not have adequate resources.
  - Restoration of the air funding package will also allow work to go forward on permit issuance such as those needed in order for Wisconsin facilities to comply with the 1990 Clean Air Act Amendments.

**AIR QUALITY**

Under current law, the owner or operator of a stationary source of air pollution who must obtain an air pollution control permit from the department of natural resources (DNR) is required to pay an annual fee to DNR. The fee is a specified amount per ton of certain air pollutants emitted by the stationary source in the preceding year, except that an owner or operator is generally not required to pay the fee for emissions of any pollutant in excess of 4,000 tons per year.

This bill establishes a new facility fee for stationary sources that emit a total of at least five tons of the pollutants on which the current fee is based. The fee ranges from \$50 to \$20,000, depending on the total amount of those pollutants emitted.

For further information see the *state and local* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

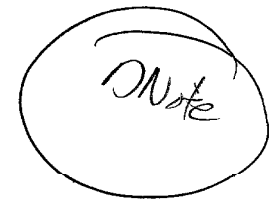
