CAUCUS AMENDMENT

TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,

TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 133

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 220, line 20: increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 1999-00 by
3 \$200,000 and increase the dollar amount for fiscal year 2000-01 by \$200,000 for the
4 purpose of providing grants to fund cooperative county-tribal law enforcement
5 programs established by Burnett County and the St. Croix Chippewa Indian tribe
6 and by Polk County and the St. Croix Chippewa Indian tribe.

7 **√ 2.** Page 1176, line 24: after that line insert:

8 "SECTION 2301d. 165.90 (4s) [√] of the statutes is created to read:

9 165.90 (4s) Notwithstanding subs. (1), [√] (3m) [√] and (4), [√] the department shall
10 approve a joint program plan submitted under this section by Polk County and the

1 St. Croix Chippewa Indian tribe and shall approve a joint program plan submitted
2 under this section by Burnett County and the St. Croix Chippewa Indian tribe. Prior
3 to January 15 of the year for which funding is sought, the department shall distribute
4 \$100,000 from the appropriations under s. 20.455 (2) (kt) to each joint program plan
5 approved under this subsection, subject to the following limitations:

6 (a) A program may use funds received under s. 20.455 (2) (kt) only for law
7 enforcement operations.

8 (b) A program shall, prior to the receipt of funds under s. 20.455 (2) (kt) for the
9 2nd and any subsequent year, submit a report to the department regarding the
10 performance of law enforcement activities on the reservation in the previous fiscal
11 year.”
