Badger Care Expansion for Child Care Workers

Expand eligibility for Badger Care to child care workers meeting the following requirements: 1. The individual is employed by a child care provider as a child care worker for at least 30 hours per week. 2. The individual's income does not exceed 185% of the poverty line, except that an individual who is already receiving health care coverage under this section may have an income that does not exceed 200% of the poverty line. The department shall establish by rule the criteria to be used to determine income. 3. The individual does not have access to employer-subsidized health care coverage and has not had access to employer-subsidized health care coverage within the time period established by the department by rule, but not to exceed 18 months, immediately preceding application for health care coverage. 4. The individual meets all other requirements established by the department by rule. The department may not require that an individual be a parent as a condition of eligibility.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Currently, under the badger care program, families with incomes below 185% of the federal poverty line who meet certain criteria are eligible for partially or wholly subsidized coverage of the same health services and benefits offered under the medical assistance program. "Family" is defined as at least one dependent child and his or her custodial parent or parents.

This bill expands the badger care program to cover individuals who are child care workers who meet the income and nonfinancial eligibility requirements. Under the bill, child care workers need not be parents to qualify for the health care coverage.

For further information see the **state and local** fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
