Rivers Protection Grant Program - Rivers Coordinator Position (No Motion Paper)

Establish a 1.0 FTE Statewide Rivers Coordinator Position (Water Resources Management Specialist). Provide \$56,700 GPR in 1999-00 and \$56,700 GPR in 2000-01. Total \$103,400.

ISSUE: Rivers Coordinator Position related to the Rivers Protection Grant Program

REQUEST: 1.00 FTE Statewide Rivers Coordinator Position (Water Resources Management Specialist-Adv. Classification; estimated annual cost: \$56,700) to be located in the Central Office within the Rivers and Regulation Section of the Fisheries Management and Habitat Protection subprogram.

ANALYSIS OF NEED: AB 133 provided for a Rivers Protection Grant Initiative requiring that the DNR develop and administer a financial assistance program to provide river protection grants for planning projects and management projects. The Joint Committee on Finance modified the Governor's proposal to, among other things, fund organizational and technical assistance efforts to promote community-based river protection groups, and to provide funding for a Watershed Center at UW-Stevens Point.

The Department requests a Rivers Coordinator FTE position to coordinate the array of river-related functions in the DNR and to provide the technical programmatic input needed to support rivers grant program operations. This position will serve as a liaison with the UW-Stevens Point Watershed Center in helping to build citizen stewardship and awareness of Wisconsin's rivers and related resources, and work to coordinate state and federal river protection programs. The Rivers Coordinator will coordinate river management policies among river basins, develop and maintain a system to establish river management plans throughout the state, and assure that river basin plans adequately protect fisheries and aquatic life habitat and the public trust in those waters.
