Department of Natural Resources - Urban Family Outdoor Skills Program

Provide \$75,000 Fish and Wildlife SBC and LFB annually to develop and operate an outdoor skills program targeted to urban families and other nontraditional outdoor recreational groups.

The Department requests \$75,000 Fish and Wildlife SEG and 1.0 FTE annually to develop and operate this outdoor skills program.

The Urban Family Outdoors Skills Program will be targeted to assist non-traditional outdoor users such as urban children, women and minority families to acquire the skills necessary to participate in camping, hiking, hunting, fishing, canoeing and other natural resource-based forms of outdoor recreation. All participants in these programs will be able to acquire skills which they can use throughout their lifetime.

Wisconsin's Urban Family Outdoors Skills Program

The Urban Family Outdoors Skills Program will be targeted to assist non-traditional outdoor users such as urban children, women and minority families to acquire the skills necessary to participate in camping, hiking, hunting, fishing, canoeing and other natural resource-based forms of outdoor recreation. All participants in these programs will be able to acquire skills which they can use throughout their lifetime.

Request

The Department requests \$75,000 Fish and Wildlife SEG and 1.0 FTE annually to develop and operate this outdoor skills program.

Proposal

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources proposes to develop new programs and relationships in the creation of this outdoor skills development proposal. To accomplish this task the Department requests 1.0 FTE Outdoor Skills Program Coordinator, to be located in DNR's Southeast Region. This individual will be responsible for the following activities.

Outreach

Promote camping, fishing, hunting, canoeing, hiking and other forms of outdoor recreation within Wisconsin's urban populations. This will involve personally meeting with leaders of African American, Hispanic and other organized urban groups (such as the African American Academy or Centro Hispano) who are generally underrepresented in outdoor recreation activities.

Work with such organizations as the Milwaukee Public Schools, Conservation Congress, Boys and Girls Clubs, church youth groups, single parent organizations, Big Brothers/Big Sisters and more.

Skills Events

In cooperation with staff at DNR properties, county parks and municipal parks, develop a full range of outdoor skills events that meet the needs of urban populations. Events will range from two-hour Urban Fishing Clinics to three-day Urban Family Outdoor Skills Weekends with the possibility of including week-long summer camps for urban children.

Cooperate with UW-Stevens Point's Becoming an Outdoors Woman program by helping generate awareness and interest in the program and by helping find participants for that program.

Purchase new or replacement existing outdoor skills equipment as needed and coordinate a "check out" system for loaning this equipment to individuals or groups requesting the use of equipment. This will include the Urban Fishing Tackle Loaner Program and the Urban Family Outdoor Skills Weekend Equipment Loaner Program.

Partnerships

Develop partnerships with Wisconsin-based outdoor recreation companies and stores to help financially sponsor Urban Outdoor Skills events.

Utilize the corps of existing local volunteer instructors (Angler Education, Hunter Education, Boating Safety Education, Learn to Hunt Program Instructors, etc.) in developing, presenting and promoting local events. Organize, train and direct the efforts of volunteers involved in urban outdoor skills events.

Promotion

Work with newspaper, television and radio media to promote upcoming events and to showcase successes. Candidate will develop promotional brochures, fliers and exhibits to be used at the Milwaukee Sports Show and State Fair and other events.

Focus programming attention on Southeast Wisconsin, but also provide leadership in other urban centers in the state, including Madison and Green Bay.

Program Development and Enhancement

In combination with DNR's statewide coordinators of outdoor skills programs and DNR's social scientists, evaluate the needs of urban children, urban women and urban families regarding learning outdoor skills and develop a process to evaluate and improve the Urban Outdoor Skills Program.

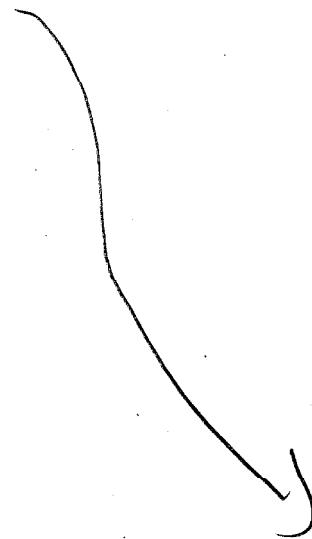
