Move to provide \$56,900 GPR and \$81,200 FED in 1999-00 and \$245,300 GPR and \$355,900 FED in 2000-01 to increase from \$184 to \$200 in 1999-00 and from \$200 to \$210 in 2000-01 the CIP IA daily rates for services provided to individuals who are relocated from the three state Centers for the Developmentally Disabled after July 1, 1999.

*Community Integration Program - taking people from the state centers and placing in the community.*

Note:

Under current law, the state provides a payment of \$184 per day to counties for the support of community-based services for developmentally disabled persons who are relocated from one of the three state Centers for the Developmentally Disabled. Current law requires that a budget reduction of \$184 per day be applied to the State Center from which the person is relocated. As a result, relocation under the CIP IA program is budget neutral. The budget bill includes a provision to increase both the CIP IA rate and budget reduction rate to \$190 per day, beginning July 1, 2000.

This motion would increase the current rate to \$200 per day in 1999-00 and \$210 per day in 2000-01 for persons relocated after July 1, 1999. This motion does not change the budget reduction rate applied to the State Centers. As a result, MA costs would increase by \$56,900 GPR and \$81,200 FED in 1999-00 and \$245,300 GPR and \$355,900 FED in 2000-01. It is assumed that the higher placement rate will increase the number of new CIP IA placements from 40 in 1999-00 and 30 in 2000-01 to 47 and 42, respectively.
