
TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 133 AND 1999 SENATE BILL 45

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 401, line 24: after that line insert:

3 "SECTION 306p. 20.370 (1) (fs) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 20.370 (1) (fs) *Endangered resources -- voluntary payments; sales, leases and*
5 *fees.* As a continuing appropriation, from moneys received as amounts designated
6 under s. 71.10 (5) (b), the net amounts certified under s. 71.10 (5) (h) 4., all moneys
7 received from the sale or lease of resources derived from the land in the state natural
8 areas system and all moneys received from fees collected under ss. 23.27 (3) (b),
9 29.563 (10) and 341.14 (6r) (b) 5., for the purposes of the endangered resources
10 program, as defined under s. 71.10 (5) (a) 2. Three percent of the moneys certified
11 under s. 71.10 (5) (h) 4. in each fiscal year, ~~but not to exceed \$100,000, and 3% of the~~



1 fees received under s. 341.14 (6r) (b) 5. in each fiscal year shall be allocated for
2 wildlife damage control and payment of claims for damage associated with
3 endangered or threatened species, except that this combined allocation may not
4 exceed \$100,000 per fiscal year."

CAUCUS AMENDMENT

TO ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1,

TO 1999 ASSEMBLY BILL 133

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 1. Page 314, line 1: delete lines 1 to 4 and substitute “(10)(h) 3. in each fiscal
3 year, but not to exceed \$100,000, shall be allocated for wildlife damage control and
4 payment of claims for damage associated with endangered or threatened species.”.
