Motion:

Move to require the Department of Health and Family Services (DHFS), by March 1, 2000, to submit a request to the Joint Committee on Finance under s. 13.10 of the statutes, to transfer \$232,400 GPR annually to the DHFS SSI administration appropriation from any other DHFS appropriation or appropriations in order to maintain the current level of administrative support provided to SSI recipients.

Note:

The biennial budget bill, as introduced by the Governor, approved by the Joint Committee on Finance and passed by the Assembly and Senate, would reduce GPR base funding for SSI administrative expenses in order to reduce funding for the Departments' state operations. This provision would require DHFS to maintain the current level of administrative support for the program by submitting a request under s. 13.10 of the statutes in order to transfer GPR funding to maintain that support.
