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


Re: MA Supplemental Hospital Payment Distribution

TO QUALIFY:

Any hospital in state with Medicaid (MA) revenues 8% or more of its total revenue.

TO DISTRIBUTE:

Add MA revenues of all qualifying hospitals to determine total MA revenue

Divide each hospital's MA revenue into the total MA revenue of the qualifying hospitals to determine its percentage.

Allocate the supplemental payment according to those percentages.
