1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

8 by the lobbyist. Upon approval of the application and payment of the applicable

10 entitles the licensee to practice lobbying on behalf of each registered principal who

1 or which has filed an authorization under s. 13.65 for that lobbyist and paid the
