WTCS grant program for recent high school graduates:

The Conference committee agreed upon a program in WTCS to provide an annual \$500 grant to WTCS students who enter the System within three years of graduation from a Wisconsin high school. This program will be available to students who:

- 1) Enter a WTCS institution within three years of graduating from a Wisconsin high school
- 2) Enroll full-time, as defined by the technical college the participant attends, in an associate degree or vocational diploma program.
- 3) Maintain a GPA of at least 2.0.
- 4) A student may participate in this grant program for two years or until the completion of his or her educational program, whichever is shorter.

In addition:

- 1) This program will be administered by the WTCS Board and the Board will promulgate rules for this program including rules regarding the obligation of students who drop to return the funds.
- 2) For the 99-01 biennium, only students who meet the requirements and are beginning their program of study in the 2000-2001 school year will be eligible for the grant. Students who are continuing, i.e., they are in the second year of a two-year program, will not be eligible for a grant.
- 3) This program will require a new appropriation.

WTCS capacity building program:

Create a new appropriation in DOA to provide grants to WTCS districts to develop or expand programs in occupational areas where there is high demand for workers as determined by DOA. DOA will distribute \$5 million in FY01 for this purpose. DOA will also be responsible for developing the criteria by which grant applications from the WTCS districts will be judged.

WTCS skilled workforce section additions for high demand skills

Create a new appropriation in the WTCSB to provide grants to aid WTCS districts in adding sections in courses where student demand exceeds current capacity. WTCSB will distribute \$2.2 million in FY01 for this purpose. The WTCS Board will develop the criteria by which grant applications from the WTCS districts will be judged.

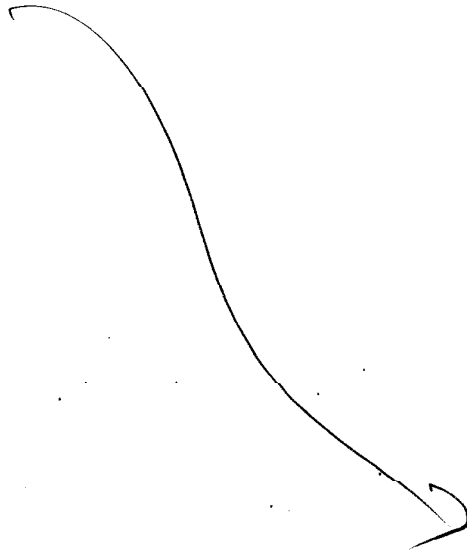
