Currently most high rise residence halls (defined as 60 ft or taller) in the University system are not fitted with automatic fire sprinkler systems. This bill would require all high rise residence halls to be retrofitted by Jan 1, 2004. This bill would also require all new residence halls in the system be fitted with fire sprinkler systems.

1 AN ACT *gen. cat*; relating to: automatic fire sprinkler systems in University of  
2 Wisconsin System residence halls.

***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

→ Under current law, a public building over 60 feet tall that was constructed after July 3, 1974, is generally required to contain an automatic fire sprinkler system on each floor. Current law also requires certain buildings under 60 feet tall to contain an automatic fire sprinkler system in limited areas within each building.

This bill requires all University of Wisconsin System residence halls over 60 feet tall that were constructed before the effective date of this bill to be fitted with an automatic fire sprinkler system on each floor before January 1, 2004. This bill also requires all University of Wisconsin System residence halls constructed on or after the effective date of this bill to be fitted with an automatic fire sprinkler system on each floor during construction.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

1. It is my understanding that you have requested a bill requiring all residence halls and dormitories in the university of Wisconsin system that are over 60 feet tall to be fitted with automatic sprinkler systems by January 1, 2004. The attached draft requires the department of commerce to promulgate a rule to accomplish this result.

2. You have also requested that the bill require all new residence halls in the system to contain automatic sprinkler systems. The attached draft does direct the department of commerce to promulgate a rule requiring all new residence halls to contain a sprinkler system on each floor. However, it is my understanding that current law already requires sprinklers in newly constructed residence halls over 60 feet tall. Section 101.14 (4) (b) 1. requires automatic sprinklers in all public buildings that are over 60 feet tall and are constructed after July 3, 1974. Section 101.14 (4) (dm) requires these sprinklers to be installed during construction of the regulated building. Furthermore, Comm 52.011 to 52.013, Wis. Admn. Code, generally require automatic sprinklers in limited locations in public buildings under 60 feet tall. If these existing provisions already meet your intent, please contact me and I will redraft the attached bill.


