9	"SECTION 2. 174.042 (1) (b) of the statutes is created to read:
10	174.042 (1) (b) A dog that is actively engaged in a legal hunting activity,
11	including training, is not considered to be running at large if the dog is monitored

- 1 or supervised by a person and the dog is on land that is open to hunting or on land
- 2 on which the person has obtained permission to hunt or to train a dog.".
