5	state capitol building at all times during which smoking is not prohibited under this
6	paragraph.".
7	${f 3.}$ Page 2, line 9: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
8	page 3, line 4, and substitute:
9	<b>"SECTION 3g.</b> 101.123 (4) (a) 1. of the statutes is amended to read:
10	101.123 (4) (a) 1. Except as provided in <del>subd.</del> <u>subds.</u> 2. <u>and 2m.</u> , a person in
11	charge or his or her agent may designate smoking areas in the places where smoking
12	is regulated under sub. (2) (a) unless a fire marshal, law, ordinance or resolution
13	prohibits smoking.

**SECTION 3r.** 101.123 (4) (a) 2m. of the statutes is created to read:

2 101.123 (4) (a) 2m. Any smoking areas that are designated in the state capitol
3 building may not permit smoking at a time when smoking in those areas is prohibited
4 under sub. (2) (ar).".
