1 AN ACT ~~to repeal~~ 16.54 (11m), 20.370 (5) (dd) and 20.370 (5) (ds); **to amend**  
2 20.370 (5) (bx); and **to create** 20.370 (5) (dd), 20.370 (5) (ds) and 59.25 (3) (rm)  
3 of the statutes; **relating to:** distribution of national forest income payments  
4 from the federal government and making appropriations.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

5 SECTION 1. 16.54 (11m) of the statutes, as created by 1999 Wisconsin Act 9, is  
6 repealed.

7 SECTION 2. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place, insert  
8 the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

5            **SECTION 3.** 20.370 (5) (bx) of the statutes, as affected by 1999 Wisconsin Act 9,  
 6 is amended to read:

7            20.370 (5) (bx) *Resource aids — national forest income aids.* All moneys  
 8 received from the U.S. government for allotments to ~~school districts~~ counties  
 9 containing national forest lands, and designated for the benefit of public roads in  
 10 such counties, shall be distributed in proportion to the national forest acreage in each  
 11 ~~school district~~ county as certified by the U.S. forest service. Such distribution shall  
 12 be made annually within 60 days after receipt of the money from the federal  
 13 government.

14            **SECTION 4.** 20.370 (5) (dd) of the statutes is created to read:

15            20.370 (5) (dd) *Payments to certain school districts; general fund.* From the  
 16 general fund, the amounts in the schedule to make the payments required under  
 17 1999 Wisconsin Act .... (this act), section 9 (1).

18            **SECTION 5.** 20.370 (5) (dd) of the statutes, as created by 1999 Wisconsin Act ....  
 19 (this act), is repealed.

20            **SECTION 6.** 20.370 (5) (ds) of the statutes is created to read:

21            20.370 (5) (ds) *Payments to certain school districts; conservation fund.* The  
 22 amounts in the schedule to make the payments required under 1999 Wisconsin Act  
 23 .... (this act), section 9 (1).

1           **SECTION 7.** 20.370 (5) (ds) of the statutes, as created by 1999 Wisconsin Act ....  
2 (this act), is repealed.

3           **SECTION 8.** 59.25 (3) (rm) of the statutes is created to read:

4           59.25 (3) (rm) If the treasurer's county receives national forest income,  
5 distribute the income to the towns in the county in which national forest lands are  
6 situated, with each town to receive such proportion of the income as the area of  
7 national forest lands in the town bears to the area of the national forest lands in the  
8 entire county. Fifty percent of the amount received by any town shall be expended  
9 by the town exclusively for the benefit of roads therein.

10           **SECTION 9. Nonstatutory provisions.**

11           (1) PAYMENTS TO CERTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICTS. No later than June 30, 2000, the  
12 secretary of natural resources shall distribute ~~\$405,800~~<sup>\$905,800</sup> from the appropriation  
13 account under section 20.370 (5) (dd) of the statutes, as created by this act, and  
14 ~~\$1,400,000~~<sup>\$900,000</sup> from the appropriation account under section 20.370 (5) (ds) of the  
15 statutes, as created by this act, to school districts that contain national forest lands  
16 within their boundaries. The distribution to each school district shall reflect the  
17 proportion of national forest acreage located within the school district. The secretary  
18 of natural resources shall distribute the payments to school districts from the  
19 appropriation under section 20.370 (5) (ds) of the statutes, as created by this act, from  
20 the amounts in the conservation fund under section 25.29 (1) (c) of the statutes.

21           **SECTION 10. Appropriation changes.**

22           (1) JOINT COMMITTEE ON FINANCE. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the  
23 statutes for the appropriation to the joint committee on finance under section 20.865  
24 (4) (a) of the statutes, as affected by the acts of 1999, the dollar amount is decreased

1 by ~~\$405,800~~ <sup>STET</sup> for fiscal year 1999-00 to decrease funding for the purposes for which  
2 the appropriation is made.

3 **SECTION 11. Effective dates.** This act takes effect on the day after publication,  
4 except as follows:

5 (1) PAYMENTS TO CERTAIN SCHOOL DISTRICTS. The repeal of section 20.370 (5) (dd)  
6 and (ds) of the statutes takes effect on July 1, 2000.
