Pre^a to the enactment of 1987 Wisconsin Act 27, the director of the legislative council staff was appointed by, and served at the pleasure of, the legislative council. The heads of the other legislative service agencies were appointed by, and served at the pleasure of, the joint committee on legislative organization. ^{JCO} ^(JCCO)

Act 27 designated the JCCO as the appointing authority for the director of the legislative council staff. Act 27 also created s. 13.90 (m)(c), ^{which is} ~~repealed~~ by this bill.

Section 13.90 (m)(c) applied to the then director of the legislative council staff. ^{and clarified} that she continued to serve at the pleasure of the legislative council for the duration of her tenure as director. That

tenure ended on November 21, 1989, thus

making s. 13.90 (m)(c) superfluous.


