This substitute amendment contains the following nonsubstantive differences from the language that was provided by Lisa Boyce:

- 1. The substitute amendment identifies the National Commission of Certifying Agencies as part of the National Organization for Competency Assurance.
- 2. The substitute amendment refers to an examination that is "approved", rather than one that is "accredited", because it seems to me that accreditation generally refers to organizations, rather than something produced by an organization, such as an examination.
