Brief Description of Intent:

To expand the membership of COLAND and to allow members to serve two consecutive terms.

Preliminary Draft - February 25, 1999

**A Proposal to Amend s. 15.377, Wis. Stats.,
Relating to the Council on Library Development (COLAND)**

Purpose: to expand the representation of library professionals and public members on COLAND; to ensure that certain types of libraries are always represented on COLAND; and to offer the opportunity for participation on COLAND by as many different library professional and public representatives as possible.

Recommended changes:

- 1) Increase the membership from 15 members to 19 members.
- 2) Increase members who are library science, audiovisual and information sciences professionals from 7 to 9.
- 3) Increase members who are public members from 8 to 10.
- 4) Designate 7 of the 9 professional members to represent the following types of libraries:
 - public library serving a municipal population of less than 6,000
 - public library serving as a public library system resource library
 - public library system
 - school library media center
 - UW System library
 - private academic library
 - special library
- 5) Members would be eligible to serve two consecutive terms of 3 years each. Current members would be eligible to serve one additional three year term after the term they are serving on June 30, 2000 expires.

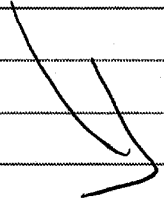
