### *Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau*

Under current law, an applicant for motor vehicle registration is required to include his or her name and address in the application, together with a description of the vehicle and other information reasonably required by the department of transportation (DOT) to enable it to register the vehicle.

This bill requires the owner to include his or her birth date in the application for registration and requires DOT to refuse to register a vehicle to any person who is younger than 16 years of age. The bill requires DOT to treat birth dates like other personal identifiers, such as name and address, for purposes of disclosure to the public.
