18 of any act or omission established by the owner thereof to have been committed or  
19 omitted without the owner's knowledge or consent. This subdivision does not apply  
20 to any vehicle owned by a person who is under 16 years of age on the date that the  
21 vehicle is used, or is intended for use, in the manner described under par. (d) (intro.),  
22 unless the court determines that the owner is an innocent bona fide owner;
